NATA Annual Convention (Anaheim, June 26-30)

- Volunteers can register online at <www.nata.org> or contact Hazel Ando at <hazelando@aol.com>. Partial registration reimbursement is available for workers.
- The district business meeting will be June 27<sup>th</sup> (11-1:30pm) at the Anaheim Hilton. A light lunch social will follow.

Primary Election ballots will be distributed in May.

- Enclosed with the ballot will be position statements for the three candidates: Cindy Clivio, Ky Kugler and Scott Sailor (position statements will also be posted on-line at <fwata.org>). PLEASE READ CANDIDATE STATEMENTS, VOTE AND RETURN BALLOTS IN A TIMELY FASHION. The top two vote getters will have a general election to follow. The new District Director will assume duties at the 2008 NATA meeting in St. Louis.
- There will not be an election for the District Secretary as Carolyn Peters was unopposed. Her position statement will be distributed with the ballot but you need not vote for this position. The Managing Board (MB) appointed Carolyn election officer and she will conduct all business related to the election.
- Several Constitutional Amendments will be included with the ballots. These amendments will allow for electronic balloting in the future. A formal vote for approval by District 8 members will be conducted at the FWATA business meeting at Anaheim.

There were nearly 700 individuals in attendance at this year's district meeting in Las Vegas, including nearly 400 Certified members and 250 student members. There were 12 Hawaii registrants for the meeting.

The district Governmental Affairs and Public Relations committees will be assisting California ATA in their efforts to pass a licensure bill for 2007-2008.

The 06-07 FWATA Operating Budget showed a surplus of \$53,000. Total assets for the district include \$119,600 in an investment account and \$170,000 in the checking account. (Las Vegas convention expenses have not been paid so total numbers will not be available until the district business meeting in Anaheim.)

The district leadership strongly supports the College/University Student Athletic Trainers Committee as they expand the programs available for curricular students. There are currently 18 Curricular Programs in CA and 1 each in HI and NV.

The FWATA History and Archives Committee received funding to provide assistance, preferably a graduate student library archivist, to handle the large volume of FWATA materials that have moved around the district. The digitalized results will provide ready access for all interested members. This may be a multi-year effort but it has already been a 10-year project.

The 2008 FWATA meeting will be April 3-6, 2008, at the Hyatt Regency San Francisco Airport in Burlingame, CA

Future FWATA meetings: 2009 San Diego, 2010 Honolulu, 2011 Las Vegas.

### **Governmental Affairs Committee: 2007 Legislative Session**

- Two pieces of legislation were introduced by the House of Representatives this session on behalf of our organization. A bill for licensure and a concurrent resolution making a second request for the State Auditor's office to perform a Sunrise Analysis.
- Each was given what is none as a triple referral meaning it had to be heard in 3 separate committees to be able to cross over to the Senate. Neither made it through that process. From what we have been told it is extremely rare for a bill to be heard in 3 committees.
- As this is the first year of a 2 year session the bills will be carried over to the 2008 session.
- We unfortunately were caught on the wrong side of political fallout within the House. There was a major shake up in leadership and our sponsor went from being quite powerful to being stripped of all leadership positions
- We will work hard this summer to lobby our cause to the Health, Education, and Consumer Protection Committee Chairs and members.
- We will also continue to follow up with the State Auditors Office to find out if they have any intention on following up the 2005 resolution regarding a Sunrise Analysis.

### **Dept of Education Athletic Trainers**

- The HMSA grant providing CPR/AED training and an AED at every school in the state (not just DOE) is moving along quickly. Many schools have already received their AED and several other schools are in the process of training their coaches/staff and getting their paperwork in order.
- Ross Oshiro has written a draft proposal for the HHSAA to submit the HIADA regarding the 1.5% weekly weight loss in wrestling. The proposal is being reviewed by the HATA Ad Hoc Wrestling Committee, as well as several administrators and coaches.
- We are still waiting on the result of our request for 20 additional positions in the public schools. The request was grouped in with the budget and is up to the legislature to approve/amend.
