



**Rainbow Wahine Softball Stadium  
Emergency Action Plan**

Emergency Personnel: Certified Athletic Trainer, Athletic Training Student(s) on site for practices and competitions; coaches, additional sports medicine staff accessible from other athletic training facilities.

Emergency Communication:

- Cellular Telephone
- Security Call Box: is located outside the main entrance to the softball stadium. This security call box is illuminated with a blue light.

Emergency Equipment: supplies (AED, spine board, and trauma kit) transported and stored in the Wahine Softball Stadium Clubhouse Athletic Training Room.

Role of First Responders:

- Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete
- Emergency equipment retrieval
- Activation of the emergency medical system
  - **Call 911** (provide name, address, telephone number, number of individuals injured, condition of injured, first aid treatment administered, specific directions, other information as requested.)
  - **DO NOT HANG UP UNTIL EMS HANGS UP**
  - Notify campus security at **x6-6911**.
- Direct EMS to scene
  - Open appropriate gates/doors
  - Designate individual to “flag down” EMS and direct to scene
  - Scene Control: limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from area.

Venue Directions: EMS personnel are to be directed to enter from the Dole Street entrance.

When coming from King Street go North on University Avenue. Turn right onto Dole Street. Turn right at the first stop light onto Lower Campus Road. Drive through the guard booth and proceed towards the Stan Sheriff Arena. Drive past the Stan Sheriff Arena and follow the road until the stop sign behind right field of the Les Murakami Baseball Stadium. Immediately turn left after passing the Les Murakami Baseball Stadium. Follow this road, there will be a set of grass fields on the right. Once passing the grass fields, there will be a gravel driveway. Proceed down this driveway and the Wahine Softball Stadium will be to your left.
